







The emerging, or emergent, church movement takes its name from the idea that as culture changes, a new church should emerge in response.



In this case, it is a response by various church leaders to the current era of post-modernism.



Although post-modernism began in the 1950s, the church didn't really seek to conform to its tenets until the 1990s.




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Post-modernism can be thought of as a dissolution of "cold, hard fact" in favor of "warm, fuzzy subjectivity." The emerging / emergent church movement can be thought of the same way.

Warning against spiritual formation

Stay away from non-biblical spiritual disciplines or methods of spiritual formation that are rooted in mysticism,

such as contemplative prayer, centering prayer, and the emerging church movement in which they are promoted.'



Contemplative prayer

A contemplative prayer or contemplation is a form of prayer in Christian mysticism. It is distinct from vocal prayer and, strictly speaking, from meditation (a form of mental prayer, also called methodical prayer...)





No ultimate truth


[Deconstruction] begins by questioning many of the assumptions of traditional interpretation.



Traditional modern interpretation, then, is fond of finding the one "true" meaning in a text, while deconstructionists do not give any one reading privileged status,







Unification through Mysticism

A Hindu theistic philosophy teaching the suppression of all activity of body, mind, and will in order that the self may realize its distinction from them and attain liberation.










HISTORY OF CHRISTIAN MYSTICISM


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Jesuit Philosophy

Ignatius of Loyola started the Society of Jesus A.K.A. the Jesuits. This was a military-like organization for the Counter-Reformation.








Throughout Christendom,

accomplish its destruction.








The Jesuits rapidly spread themselves over Europe, and wherever they went, there followed a revival of popery.




Jesus is the Way
