





Nehemiah 13:12-13


¹² Then all Judah brought the tithe of the grain and the new wine and the oil to the storehouse. ¹³ And I appointed as treasurers over the storehouse... for they were considered faithful, and their task *was* to distribute to their brethren.

Addressing the giving and allocation of funds



In those days I saw people in Judah treading winepresses on the Sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and loading donkeys with wine, grapes, figs, and all kinds of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day. And I warned them about the day on which they were selling provisions.

Men of Tyre dwelt there also, who brought in fish and all kinds of goods, and sold *them* on the Sabbath to the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.



Does the Bible actually say not to buy and sell on the Sabbath?


The foreigners among them were doing it



Violation of God's Law was indicative of what was in their hearts.

Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said to them, "What evil thing is this that you do, by which you profane the Sabbath day?

Did not your fathers do thus, and did not our God bring all this disaster on us and on this city? Yet you bring added wrath on Israel by profaning the Sabbath."




Open rebellion is what got us into this mess in the first place.

So it was, at the gates of Jerusalem, as it began to be dark before the Sabbath, that I commanded the gates to be shut, and charged that they must not be opened till after the Sabbath. Then I posted some of my servants at the gates, so that no burdens would be brought in on the Sabbath day.



Desperate times call for desperate measures. Nehemiah purposed to protect the fringes of the Sabbath.

Then I warned them, and said to them, "Why do you spend the night around the wall? If you do so again, I will lay hands on you!" From that time on they came no more on the Sabbath.



Trading near the city on the Sabbath is now enforced.

And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and that they should go and guard the gates, to sanctify the Sabbath day.

Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy!



And half of their children spoke the language of Ashdod, and could not speak the language of Judah, but spoke according to the language of one or the other people.



When paganism mixes with God's people.

So I contended with them and cursed them, struck some of them and pulled out their hair, and made them swear by God, saying, "You shall not give your daughters as wives to their sons, nor take their daughters for your sons or yourselves.

Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? Yet among many nations there was no king like him, who was beloved of his God; and God made him king over all Israel. Nevertheless pagan women caused even him to sin.



King Solomon had 700 wives, princesses and 300 concubines; and his wives turned away his heart.

Remember them, O my God, because they have defiled the priesthood and the covenant of the priesthood and the Levites.

Thus I cleansed them of everything pagan. I also assigned duties to the priests and the Levites, each to his service,
